nothing but plaine Bakers bread; & plaine wine in a Cup and I do beleiue [tha]t all my
Ancestors and all others, [tha]t ha{ve} liued in [tha]t faith are damned & p[er]ished for euer:
Theref{ore} I p[ro]mise before god & [th]e Virgin Mary his Moth[e]r & before {the} preist
and pastor of soules being in [th]e place of god here p[er]
